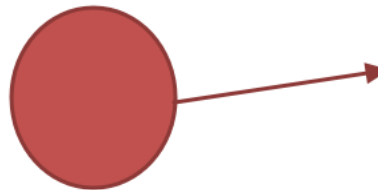
[Cochrane Reviews](#) are systematic reviews of primary research in human health care and health policy, and are internationally recognised as the highest standard in evidence-based health care.


