




After you login, click on your course, you may see more than one.




To allow course changes, click the "turn editing on" button, in the top right corner.




Now you can add Resources or Activities



Individual parts of the course can be described with the label option which allows you to type text on the course page.




The label option opens a Window for typing.




Each section of the course should have some text inserted which explains it.

This icon can be used to paste text from MS Word, for example.


