The AMA-IMG Section

The American Medical Association has a section for International Medical graduates (IMGs) at www.ama-assn.org/go/imgs. There are several resources available for medical students and grads including the online newsletter the AMA eVoice, which includes AMA –IMG news and useful information for residency applications.

Delta Student Loans

Application deadline for Delta Student Loans for the Fall semester is July 16th. No applications will be accepted after that date. The application form can be found on the school website in the Financial Assistance section.

Clinical Students

Students starting rotations at Jackson Park Hospital will now require CPR certification. A CPR certification card must be submitted to the Medical Department of JPH on the 1st day of rotation. This is not applicable to AICM students.

Billing for Fall 2010

Tuition bills for Fall 2010 will be issued July 1st are due July 30th. Late fees of up to \$400 may be assessed. Please make your payments on time to avoid these fees.

New Exam Master Feature

The ExamMaster Online system now has a new feature: Flashcards. This is available when you log in, among the buttons on the left. Select "Flashcards" and you can create, edit and view unlimited individual flashcards, and file them into flashcard groups. You can also convert study notes into a flashcard by selecting "Make this note a flashcard". A Help file is also available.

AICM

The first AICM course set to begin on July 6th with 11 students at Jackson Park Hospital, Chicago. Over the next 16 weeks they will be introduced to all areas of clinical medicine, and undergo in depth USMLE prep. We welcome them to Chicago and hope they will have a fruitful 16 weeks. Rotation Cancellation Policy

To ensure that sought-after rotation slots do not go unfilled after the time and effort that the school and hospital put in to making these available, a penalty of \$500 will be assessed for students who cancel a scheduled rotation.
