Billing and payment policy info

We would like to remind all the students that of the general info about the billing and payments. Saint James School of Medicine bills the current students three times in the year- beginning of each March, July and November. The due dates for these invoices are 30 days after the invoices are sent out, and generally one month before the semester starts. Once the invoice is past due, there is an automatic \$200 late fee attached to it. If you are interested into applying for payment plan you MUST do so before the due date of the invoice.
